A foreign Truckmixer driver in London managed to get a small amount of acid into his eye when he used a personal supply contained within a spray bottle to clean the back of his truck! The wind blew a tiny amount into his face. He was very lucky that he did not get an amount significant enough to warrant flushing his eye and his tear ducts apparently washed out the contaminant.

These photoTMs show the effects of chemical contamination of the eyes. If acid gets into the eye, it is imperative to immediately flush them with water for 10-15 minutes!
