The 2024 Awards were introduced by Lex Russell, MPA Chair, who emphasised not only his personal commitment to ensuring that everyone in the workforce went home safe and well every day, but the determination of the MPA Board members to improve health and safety within the industry.

Encouraging everyone to think of how they could apply something highlighted in the awards within their own organisation, he stated that: "A vital element in delivering this goal is the sharing of information about both good practice within the industry and incidents, particularly those incidents in which people have or could have been seriously injured. By learning from each other and sharing information, we will achieve a safer environment for all. The MPA Health and Safety Awards coupled with the information on Safequarry such as the incident alerts, Hipo's, guidance and good practice play a critical role in facilitating this."

INCIDENT ALERTS, HiPo's and SAFEQUARRY

Safequarry has recently been updated to include a new <u>HiPo report</u> which combined with <u>incident alerts</u> provides users with an incite into the serious incidents that have occurred on other sites across the mineral products industry.
