Nominations can be based on an individual's contribution to a specific project or more broadly based on the leadership they have demonstrated in improving health and safety within their workplace.

HOW EASY IS IT TO ENTER?

It is very easy to enter, simply complete a couple of paragraphs on the Word form to explain why you have nominated an employee for this award. **Entries must be submitted by the 17th October 2025.**

- Highly motivating for the individual and their colleagues
- Demonstrates the importance of individuals in driving change
- Demonstrates the high value your company places on health and safety
- Demonstrates commitment to Vision Zero values
- Helps build health and safety culture within your organisation
- Winners widely promoted across industry
- Excellent for your communications with employees, customers and other stakeholders

WHO CAN ENTER?

To submit an entry for either award your company must be a member of MPA. It is assumed that the nomination will be made by the employee's line manager or someone more senior within the organisation.

Individual Recognition nominees and short-listed Young Leader entries will feature during the MPA Health & Safety event on the 7th July 2026. This provides an ideal opportunity for companies to celebrate their nomination and ensure wider industry recognition for their employees achievements'.

YOUNG LEADER

- Based on nominations from companies for employees under 30 years of age on the 31st December 2025. There were 12 nominations in 2024.
- The judges will review the entries and select finalists. You may be contacted by a judge to discuss your nomination. The winner/s will be selected from a short list of finalists.
